We are happy to report that the celebrity wait night at the Doc's on April 23rd raised over \$35,000 for Bethany House. These proceeds fund Bethany House's free services, which include long-term apartment-style domestic violence shelters and specialized advocacy efforts which give survivors the safety, time and resources they need to begin recovering from the trauma of abuse.

Last year Bethany sheltered 27 households, including 58 children. The average length of stay was 12 months, empowering survivors to not only physically and emotionally begin to heal, but also to get on their feet financially.

Every \$1 invested in Bethany House saves our community more than \$65 in social costs such as police enforcement, lost work productivity, legal system, and mental health costs. Bethany House is a sponsored ministry of the Sisters of St. Francis in Sylvania, Ohio. We are grateful to the many parishioners who were so generous in both attending this event and well as those making donations!
