Special Baptism at Mass

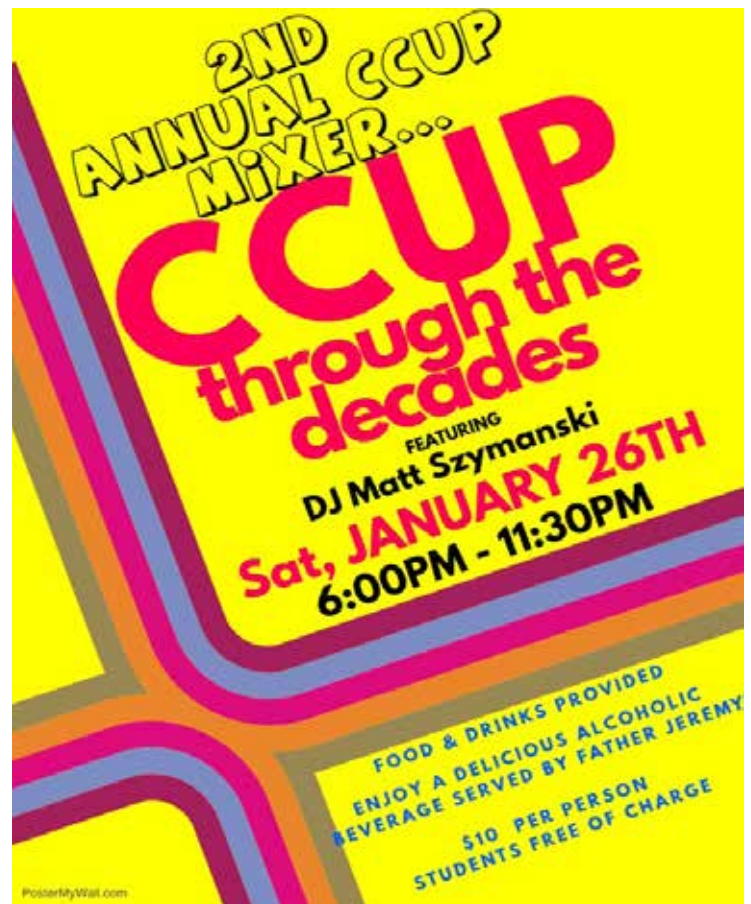
