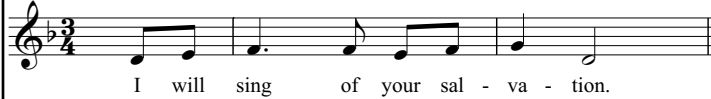

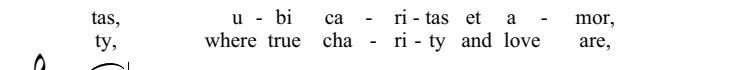

**Diocese of Toledo Safe Environment Program:** The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric, personnel, or volunteer of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Child Protection Services, and to contact Mr. Frank DiLallo, diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at 419-214-4880 or to write to Mr. DiLallo at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, OH 43604.

**Official Policy of the Diocese of Toledo Regarding Level 3 Snow Emergencies:** Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a **Level 3 Snow Emergency**, during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in that geographic region are also cancelled.

Pax Christi at CCUP is pleased to sponsor an educational presentation on Single Payer Health Care in Ohio on **Sunday, February 17 immediately following the 11:00 AM Mass**. The presenter is Johnathon Ross, MD MPH, Assoc. Prof. of clinical medicine at UT, teacher and practitioner of general internal medicine at St. Vincent Mercy Medical Center and longtime member of the Single-Payer Action Network of Ohio. A single payer approach to health care is one of the proposals for fixing the imperfections of our current system. From the parish standpoint, this event is meant to be educational, not promotional. The goal is to foster an open and informative conversation on how to guarantee affordable, accessible, and quality health care in our country. Those who are suspicious of single payer health care are encouraged to attend to promote a balanced conversation.
