From the Pastor...

Summer Mass Information

Based on the survey results, Mass on Sunday morning will remain at 11 a.m. during the summer months. I set the 2/3 threshold because if we have been having Mass at that time for the past seven years, it seemed reasonable to me that it would have to be an overwhelming majority to overturn it. The results showed a 57% vote in favor of the change, quite a bit short of the 67% needed.

Thank you for your input and your understanding on this matter. Sorry for any inconvenience this might cause. Feel free to talk to me with any questions or concerns.

Also, a reminder that last year we started celebrating the 4:30 p.m. all year round. The compromise for having it all year round was that Luke would not be present for music at this Mass when the students are out of session. Thus, starting on May 11th, the 4:30 p.m. Mass will have a simpler feel, with a few songs led a capella.

Finally, the last 6 p.m. Sunday Mass is April 28th, with the student Mass resuming on August 25th.

Preaching on the Tapestries - In the summer months, I am going to try something a little different for the homilies at Mass. I am going to use 12 weeks from early May to mid-August to preach on the 12 different tapestries in our church. They are such a gem in our worship space, and I want to speak a little more in depth about each of the individuals, while also tying their life and teachings to the Sunday readings.
