From Fr. Jeremy...

The summer months are a good time for us to get some work done around the building since things slow down quite a bit. I wanted to let you know about a few projects on the horizon.

First, we have just received permission from the diocese to finish our LED lighting retrofit project. About two years ago, the parking lots and all other lights except the worship space were converted to LED lighting. The last phase is the retrofitting of the worship space. This is a more expansive project. The diocese requires any capital expense over \$30,000 to be approved through them. I also discussed this with the Finance Council since we would be taking a significant amount out of our endowed building fund. We all agreed that this was a necessary update given that our current lighting system is operated on floppy disks!! The work will take place during the week primarily in the month of July. It will not impact our weekend worship.

Second, beginning this week, the Newman Rooms and Zak Lounge will be receiving a major facelift. The rooms are an incredible space for our students, but over the last two years, the students have casually mentioned a number of things they would love to see in the rooms. Kim and I set up a committee of students who use the room frequently to discuss ideas. We have a number of parishioners and friends helping us on the project. Funds will be taken from the donations directed to this cause during the 20th anniversary events last fall, my Lenten concert, Fr. Dan Zak's memorial fund for his brother, and donations from some parents of our CSA students. The rooms will be out of commission for most of the summer.

Third, we have been looking into an updating of the parish kitchen. A number of parishioners who use the kitchen frequently approached me last year with the view that the current setup and appliances are insufficient for the volume and frequency with which it is currently being used. I gave them permission to initiate some consultations and estimates. They outlined a number of main needs: a second larger refrigerator, an industrial dishwasher, and more countertop space. We are still receiving estimates and I will keep you updated on this project as it progresses.
