Kitchen Renovation

As I mentioned in the bulletin a few weeks ago, a few parishioners have been working for a number of months on the prospect of a kitchen renovation. Over the last two years, it has become clear to us that our current kitchen set up, as well as some of the current appliances, no longer adequately meet the needs of its high frequency use. We are consistently serving dinner to around 150 students every Sunday, and we continue to host large gatherings such as the symphony, which would greatly benefit from a more commercial style kitchen.



While there are a number of proposed smaller changes, the two big appliance additions would be a large refrigerator to supplement the refrigerator we


already have, and a large industrial dishwasher to accelerate the dishwashing process for our large gatherings.




The entire project - appliances and labor - comes to around \$25,000. Normally, we could draw from our building endowment fund for a project of this nature. However, this year (the church LED project) and in the foreseeable future, we have significant projects to address with this fund, and we are trying to be responsible by only drawing out the interest going forward.

We know that this project would greatly assist all the parishioners who volunteer their time and talent for the student dinners and other events we host here at CCUP. 


