As of last weekend, you will notice a difference in the procedure after Communion for our Eucharistic Ministers. Deacon Justin and I will be purifying the vessels at the credence table (the table between the ambo and the presider's chair), which means that in general all the distributors will be returning their vessels there and not processing back to the sacristy as they have done in the past. A few of the distributors have been tasked with distributing to those who cannot come forward for communion before returning to the credence table.

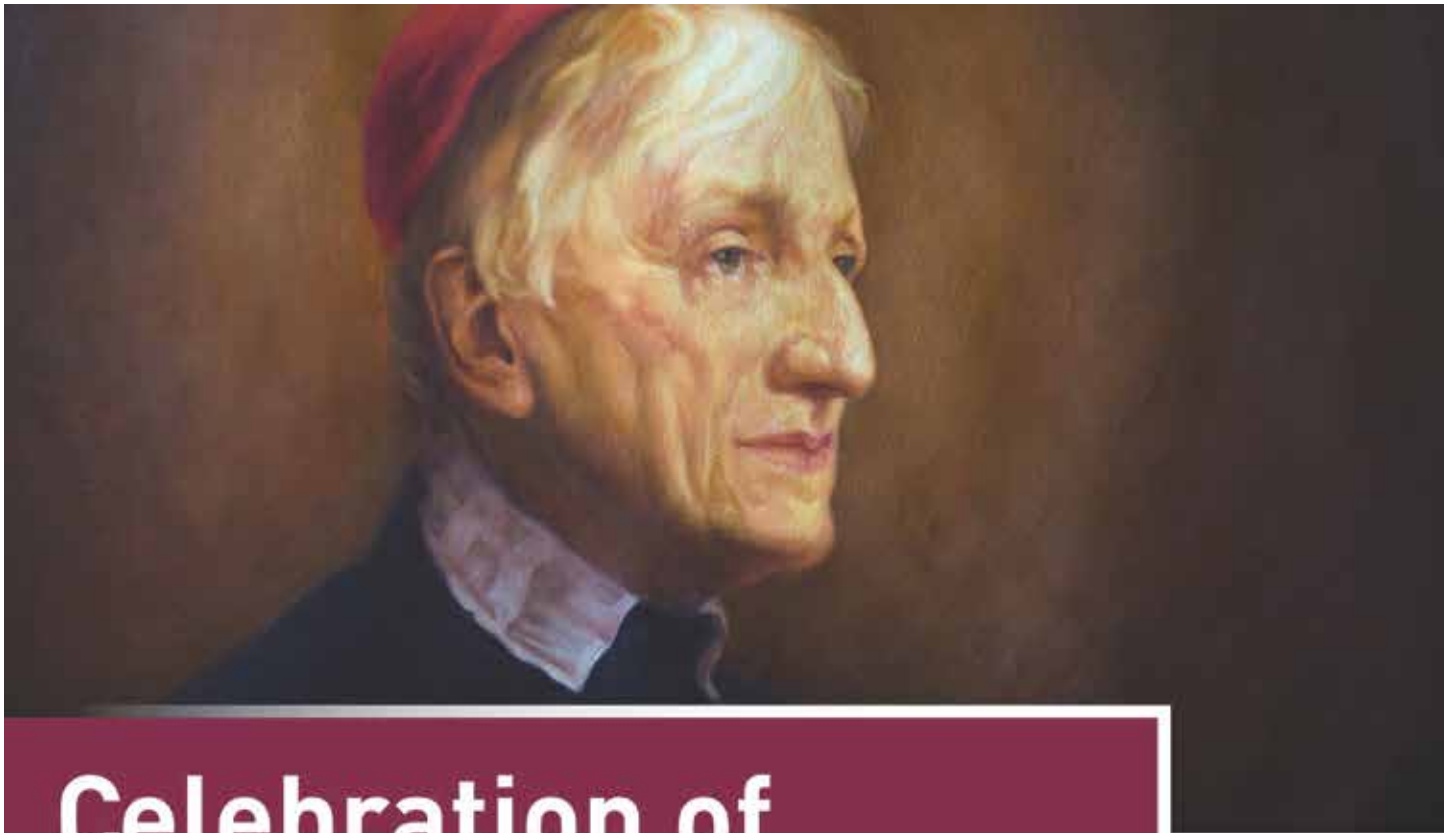

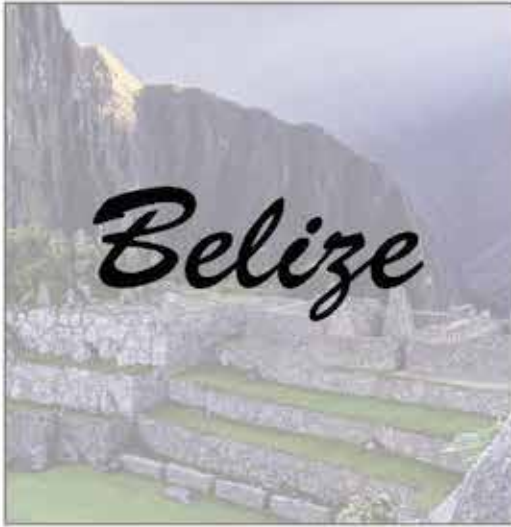
JOIN US FOR HOMECOMING FUN!

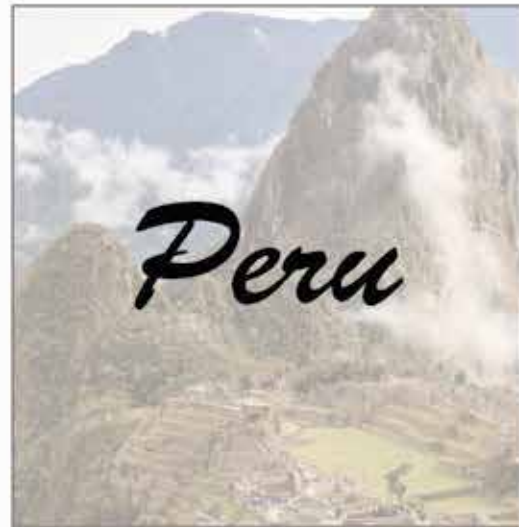
