How is the magazine funded? It is funded through advertising, grants, the annual Catholic Communication Campaign collection, and reader support (we have an envelope in this issue for those who would specifically like give to the magazine – receiving the magazine is not dependent on a donation).

How often will the magazine be published? We plan to publish twice per year.

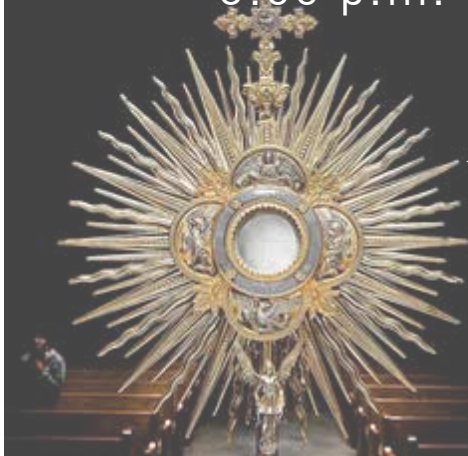


