Thomas, in union with the Bishops of Ohio, has [extended the temporary suspension of all publicly celebrated Masses/liturgies at least through and including Sunday, May 3rd.](#) The Bishops of Ohio dispense the Catholic faithful who reside in their respective dioceses and all other Catholics currently in Ohio from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass during this time period.

CCUP offers the opportunity each spring for students to apply for four scholarships available through the parish. They are each listed below with their criteria briefly described. Please read the criteria in the application directions carefully before applying to make sure you are eligible. The links for each online application are listed below each scholarship heading.

The deadline for applying is **Wednesday, April 29, 2020 by 5 p.m. EST.** All applications must be submitted by the deadline and all essays/letters of recommendations must be received by then as well.

Due to the Corona Virus and the cancellation of the spring semester, you will be contacted via email by May 6th announcing who received the scholarships.

Here are the four scholarships available through CCUP:

John Henry Newman Scholarship: Those applying for this scholarship must be at least a sophomore with a minimum of 2 years of active membership in the Catholic Student Association. Roger and Norma Weiher Scholarship: This \$500 award will be awarded to a University of Toledo senior who is a Catholic registered at Corpus Christi University Parish and has been accepted into a graduate program at any university.
