Parish Update

Friends,

Since Governor Dewine moved Lucas County to a Red Level 3 advisory, **masks are required at all Masses beginning this weekend.**

We will place signage and masks front and center at the entrance of the church to remind people of the mandate. There are exemptions to this mandate, and I invite you to read the order if you think an exemption might apply to you. I would ask for good will on both sides. I would ask that we don't hide behind an exemption simply because we don't want to wear a mask. On the other hand, I would ask that we assume anyone not in a mask has a legitimate reason to do so. *I feel strongly about not policing mask wearing.*

I realize that masks have become a divisive issue and I have heard from people in the parish with strong opinions on both sides. During the level 3 warning, we need to all be unified in complying with the mandate so long as we are not exempt. When the level 3 is lifted, I will propose a Mass schedule with mask policies that try to find some middle ground.

In the coming weeks, I will write more on my approach to student ministry in the fall and what COVID changes we will be making.

Communion Outside During the 11 a.m. Mass

We invite those who still feel uncomfortable worshipping in the church to live-stream the Mass in their car or outside on our grounds and still be able to receive Holy Communion as part of our parish community.

When communion starts inside church, a Eucharistic minister will bring communion to those gathered outside the east side door of church. The Eucharistic minister will be wearing a mask. People will be invited to come forward with social distance to receive communion.

Since our live-stream feed sometimes lags behind, please make your way to the side door during the singing of the Lamb of God.

If it is raining outside, the Eucharistic minister will be positioned just inside the side door and people should enter one by one to receive.

Manna Bags

Manna bags are back and will be sold after all three Masses the weekend of July 18-19, 2020. Each gallon-size freezer bag costs \$3 and contains three dollar's worth of non-perishable food, water, and juice, suitable for handing out to people in need you encounter on the street. For this sale, in consideration of the pandemic, each bag will also contain a disposable face mask. Bags will be sold from both parking lots, weather permitting, in a socially distant manner. Cash only, please. Given the increased potential need, no limit is being placed on the number of bags each family can purchase.

Claver House

The Claver House Food Ministry has been providing "grab 'n' go" bagged meals for their clients since the Covid 19 shut down in March. They have recently resumed dine-in meals once a week, and are ready to receive casserole donations from our parishioners.
