



What is Flocknote?

Flocknote is a network system that helps parishes connect by text message, e-mail, phone, etc.. - If we already have your information, you will automatically be transferred
- If we only have a cell phone number on file for you and not an email, **you will receive all our email updates as texts**
- If you receive the communication as an email but would like to as a text, you can either:
 - Do it yourself by creating a log-in in response to an email or text you've received
 - Contact Becky at the parish office who can change it for you
- Unsubscribing from text or email is simple:
 - Text "STOP" in response to a text message
 - Click "Unsubscribe" at the bottom of an email message

Communion Outside During the 11 a.m. Mass

We invite those who still feel uncomfortable worshipping in the church to live-stream the Mass in their car or outside on our grounds and still be able to receive Holy Communion as part of our parish community.

When communion starts inside church, a Eucharistic minister will bring communion to those gathered outside the east side door of church. The Eucharistic minister will be wearing a mask. People will be invited to come forward with social distance to receive communion.

Since our live-stream feed sometimes lags behind, please make your way to the side door during the singing of the Lamb of God.

If it is raining outside, the Eucharistic minister will be positioned just inside the side door and people should enter one by one to receive.
